



Bio-Blitz & Survey for the endangered Prairie Skink

Saturday, June 26th

10:00am to 3:00pm

Join partners of and researchers from the Nature Conservancy of Canada, Brandon University, the University of Manitoba, Brandon Naturalist Society and the Prairie Skink Recovery Team in a complete plant and animal survey of the Yellow Quill Prairie Preserve located southeast of Brandon near CFB Shilo Manitoba.



Volunteers will assist in the search for the endangered Prairie Skink, as well as for the nationally threatened Sprague's Pipit and a number of provincially uncommon species such as Smooth Green Snake which the Preserve's mixed-grass prairie supports. All sightings of plant and animal species collected will be added to a national data base to assist in future conservation and stewardship programs.

The event will begin from Criddle-Vane Provincial Park located south of CFB Shilo.
